

Teaching Excellence Framework: Year two



Statement of findings The University of East Anglia

This award was made in June 2017 and is valid for up to three years.

The TEF Panel reviewed the provider metrics and provider submission according to the process and criteria specified in the TEF guidance.

The provider metrics supplemented by the submission indicate that students achieve excellent outcomes. The metrics indicate very high levels of satisfaction with teaching and academic support, notably exceeding the provider's benchmark. Very high proportions of full-time (majority mode) students progress to employment or further study, while progression to highly skilled employment or further study is marginally below benchmark. Retention of part-time students is below the provider's benchmark, and the Panel deemed this to be partially addressed in the provider submission.

The Panel considered all the information in the provider submission in relation to the TEF criteria and its judgement reflects, in particular, evidence of:

- promotion processes that recognise excellent teaching practice and university support for student-led teaching awards
- a strategic approach to personalised learning which secures high levels of commitment to studies and uses a Peer Assisted Learning scheme to provide tailored student support
- a commendable strategic approach to employability through placements, business partnerships and a well-equipped careers service
- investment in high quality physical and digital resources that have had a demonstrable impact on the student learning experience.

Overall, the TEF Panel judged that the combination of evidence in the provider metrics and the provider submission best fits the descriptor for a Silver award.
