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



Preface

This story got more attention that I anticipated so I am adding this preface for context. I usually write expository prose. On the May long weekend I began writing a detective/thriller themed version of real life events that occurred in one of the classes I taught during Fall 2021. I shared the posts on twitter, and released them incrementally as I wrote them. I took poetic license in this story and embellished the presentation for effect and to create cliffhangers for some of the folks on twitter who were interested in the story. I characterized myself as a plagiarism detective and told the story around that character. I am not actually a plagiarism detective, and as an educator I value and celebrate different victories than the plagiarism detective does here. In this story, when the plagiarism detective appears gleeful, I was experiencing a lot of stress and sadness. I left out much of the reasoning process that went into the actions I took, and I consulted at great length with my colleagues and academic integrity office throughout the ordeal. And, I'm still reflecting on and discussing the approach I took with my colleagues. This story was an end-of-semester creative writing exercise I used to reflect on my experience. I thought some of my colleagues might find it interesting. There are many mistakes that I make in this story, and I would not repeat them again. The process of telling this story helped me gain new perspectives that will improve my teaching.



The rise of cheating in UK universities

As universities continue to commodify education, increasing numbers of students are buying and selling essays

This time two years ago, Vicky* was curled up at her desk in her student house in Leeds, her face lit up by the blue light of her laptop, with a freshly-brewed coffee warming her hands. She had to write a 2,500-word university essay on social work, and wasted no time in putting her nose to the grindstone. Over the next few weeks, she spent hours researching, planning, writing, and proofreading. Eventually, after deleting all the comma splices and shifting the paragraphs around, she created a piece of work she was proud of.

Condition B4: Assessment and awards

The provider must ensure that students are assessed effectively, that each assessment is valid and reliable and that academic regulations are designed to ensure that relevant awards are credible.

"academic misconduct" means any action or attempted action that may result in a student obtaining an unfair academic advantage in relation to an assessment, including but not limited to plagiarism, unauthorised collaboration and the possession of unauthorised materials during an assessment.

"assessed effectively" means assessed in a challenging and appropriately comprehensive way, by reference to the subject matter of the higher education course, and includes but is not limited to assessments being designed in a way that minimises the opportunities for academic misconduct and facilitates the detection of such misconduct where it does occur.

A provider not taking reasonable steps to detect and prevent plagiarism, students' use of essay mills, or other forms of academic misconduct by students, would likely be of Concern.

B2: Support relating to avoiding academic misconduct includes support for essay planning and accurate referencing, and advice about the consequences of academic misconduct.





AAA 2022

- 16% of respondents admitted to cheating in online assessments this academic year (140/900).
- The reported methods of cheating were mostly mundane, unsophisticated and show the ease with which cheating occurred.
- Only 5% of those who admitted to cheating had ever been caught.
- 52% of respondents knew people who had cheated in online assessments this academic year.
- 79% of respondents believed it was easier to cheat online than in exam halls (707/900), with 42% saying that they would be less likely to cheat in an exam hall (378/900).
- 37% of respondents reported that their university took no measures to stop cheating in online assessments (334/900).
- 33% of respondents believed cheating in online assessments was either 'not wrong' or only 'mildly wrong' (299/900), with 37% believing it was 'very wrong' (329/900).



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

But in this pandemic, students' confidence has taken a hit - and contract cheating vendors see the opportunity in this vulnerability to monetise the student

Right now there are around 1000 contract cheating vendors advertised online. This "industry" creates so much revenue that it has a comparison website. But it doesn't just wait for students to seek its services - it actively engages with students where they are.

Through social media advertising, private messaging a student who puts a status up saying they are struggling, and even finding ways to access institutional emails and hacking university websites, students are pressured by these companies.
