
Over 8 million households to get new Cost of Living payment from 14 July 2022

- Universities responding surprisingly badly to negative content in drafts – but fades (see grief curve)






Housing shortage

Strikes

- Dates called: 24th, 25th, 30th
- See strike sheet for SU approaches
- Wednesday 30th National Demo King's Cross
 - Unlikely to be ultra vires weigh up record
- Action short of a strike
 - working to contract
 - not covering for absent colleagues
 - removing uploaded materials related to, and/or not sharing materials related to, lectures or classes that will be or have been cancelled as a result of strike action
 - not rescheduling lectures or classes cancelled due to strike action
 - not undertaking any voluntary activities.
- Need to know briefing, rights issues briefing
- Don't forget <u>nursing if you have nursing students</u> (dates TBC)
- Picketing some unis dissuading students <u>see briefing</u>
- International students and attendance see briefing







Free speech bill

- Amendments for report stage potentially:
 - Removal of tort
 - Regulation of SUs through universities
 - Removal of clause on foreign funding
 - Heckler's veto clause
 - Complaints route
- Becomes law late 22 / early 23, then OfS consultation

- Search Lords register of interests to find links to your uni










- No news (yet) on immigration reform but figures coming December

Transport

- The pandemic has caused more WFH, passenger numbers have not bounced back, and many routes are less sustainable than they were, putting huge pressure on operator margins
