#### What is Authentic Assessment?

- Assessment for learning: process and/or product
- 'Performance of understanding' v 'Verbal retelling' (Biggs & Tang, 2011)
- Applies knowledge, skills and ways of thinking and practising in analytical and thoughtful ways
- Relevant to disciplinary ways of practising and knowing
- Prepares "students for life after graduation" (QAA, 2023)
- Students express their learning through their own voice
- Draws on creativity, evokes curiosity & develops confidence
- Etymology: autos (self) + hentes (doer, being)

'Dethroning the essay': Rebecca Feasey & James Baggott-Brown, Bath School of Art, Film & Media

- Exegesis (illustrated critical text exploring your own creative practice) | 5,000 words
- Curated online exhibition with supporting text/s | 3,000 words + 2,000 word production diary
- C-Port (Critical **Portfolio**) | 5,000 words (divided between 4-5 shorter texts)
- Presentation/ Mini-Documentary | 4-16 minutes (script and references to be submitted to Turnitin)
- Art critical magazine (online or physical/zine/website) | 3,000 words + 2,000 word production diary
- Art Critical Writing (illustrated 'essay' option) | 5,000 words

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
