# Data Sharing between SU's and Universities

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### Background

- Prof Edward Peck (NTU VC) appointed in June 2022 by Minister Donelan
- Provide leadership, share best practice and promote innovation in student support
- Student mental health: what are the best ways of supporting students suffering with serious mental illness?
- ► Key issue: discrepancy between disclosure (5%)¹ vs prevalence (27% 57%)²
- Issue is exacerbated by poor links with the NHS and complex systems of support

#### Recent Policy Developments

- Increased focus on student mental health = increased focus of universities
- Backdrop of growing resource requirement against tightening financial constraints
- ► LEARN Network and Duty of Care debate in Parliament
- New Taskforce
  - Adoption of good practice
  - Early warning/identification of student risk
  - National student suicide review
  - Compassionate communications and processes
- What role for SUs in this context?

#### **HEP-SU Information Sharing Guide**

- Problem:
  - ► Students falling between gaps between SUs and HEPs
  - Lack of formal process and trust between SUs and HEPs
  - Confusion around data protection and data sharing
- Provide guidance on how to share data between SU and HEP when there are serious concerns for a student's health, wellbeing or safety:
  - Advice Centres
  - Student-led Groups
  - ► SU physical spaces (e.g., bars)
  - Student death (particularly suicide)
- Specific recommendations and case studies (e.g., data sharing agreements, privacy notices)
- ► ICO position on data sharing and outline of data protection regulation
