

Student Unions' Commitments



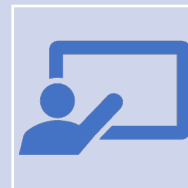
Offer a range of extracurricular opportunities for students for them to gain transformational skills and experience that they can relate to career aspirations and wider employment focused work.
