Approved at the general meeting of the Union of Estonian Student Unions on 08.05.2022 Explanation letter

The Estonian Student Union (EÜL) is an umbrella organization of students whose purpose is to stand up for the rights, needs and interests of students at the national level and to support student councils in their work. Students have **three** basic **expectations for parliamentary power and the future government:**

- 1. Free higher education and adequate financing of higher education.
 - 1.1. Every resident of Estonia must have the right to free Estonian for higher education in full-time level studies.
 - 1.2. In order to achieve the aforementioned, higher education funding must rise to at least 1.5% of GDP, and in the future, higher education funding must rise at the same pace as the cost of living.
- Sufficient social guarantees that allow students to concentrate to learning.
 - 2.1. Study grants must help those who do not have sufficient other income to study, and working while studying must be a choice, not an economic compulsion. 2.2.
 Study grants must be indexed
 - to the cost of living so that their effect and purpose would not be clouded.
 - 2.3. In addition to need-based study grants, the performance scholarship fund must be strengthened so that the available amounts are truly motivating.

- 2.4. The state must create a mechanism to cancel student loans under certain conditions, reduce student loan interest to 0% and guarantee student loans for all students.
- 3. Supporting students' mental health and well-being.
 - 3.1. We expect concrete action from the state to support the mental health of students, including the expansion and implementation of the planned strategy for young people for students as well.
 - 3.2. We want targeted funding from the state to support higher education institutions, incl to provide psychological counseling.
 - 3.3. Students with special needs must be guaranteed higher education in terms of organization, study content and support systems.
