1 Blanket policies don't work

- AI in education is complex
- One-size-fits-all responses fail
- Compliance-led approaches miss the point

2 The shift needed

- Move from prohibition to enablement
- Focus on pedagogy, not just tools
- Use pilots to learn what works



Creating the conditions for responsible AI use

1 Institutions need to enable clear but flexible foundations

- Principles and guardrails, not rigid policy
- Shared minimum expectations for safety and ethics
- Space for disciplinary judgement

2 Enablement in practice

- Secure, ring-fenced infrastructure
- AI embedded in staff and student workflows
- Time, trust and support to experiment
- The right partner, with the right tools
